Membership Criteria Guidelines for Priest Category.

- Applicant seeking membership as Archaka, Purohita, Pujari must be must be currently serving as a Archaka (Agamic Temple Priest) and or Purohita (Domestic Priest) or as a Pujari in a temple in Australia.
- All applicants must fill out all the information (indicated with **) on the prescribed membership application form.
- Only a signed and dated hard copy of the membership application form will be accepted for processing.
- ACHC reserves the right to reject the application if the application is incomplete and/or the applicant is found to be not a fit and proper person.
- All new applications should be accompanied by a copy of the applicant's qualification/s (i.e. certificates awards etc.)
- Details should be provided of past and current work experience from the relevant employer/s, temple/s, in the case of temple priest. In the case of Purohita, a letter of support signed by 50 heads of families from the Australian Hindu community (along with contact details of the persons signed). The letter should acknowledge that the applicant is well known to them and the applicant is their family and or preferred priest.
- Every applicant must be recommended by two current ACHC members, one of whom must be a serving committee member.
- All the new membership applications either received in person or via post shall be tabled at ACHC's monthly meeting for processing, and the successful applicant shall be informed of the outcome as soon as it is practical.
